







- Teddy Roosevelt
- OBJECTIVE:
 - KEEP EUROPE OUT
 of Latin America
 (Roosevelt Corollary
 to the Monroe Doctrine)
 - USE FORCE to defend American interests in Latin America

The "Roosevelt Corollary" to the Monroe Doctrine


European nations should stay out of the Americas, altogether...

















Dollar Diplomacy

- OBJECTIVE:
 - SUPPORT democratic governments in Latin
 America
 - OPPOSE oppressive or undemocratic governments
